



Community Bubs is a philanthropically-funded program run by Family Life that supports families in the community to ensure babies thrive and develop in a safe and supportive environment.

Community Bubs is an outreach program which provides case management to parents/carers in their final trimester of pregnancy, and/or in the early stages following their child's birth.

Families can be supported by Community Bubs for a period of up to 9 months, where Community Bubs Practitioners can assist families with:

- Building parenting skills and confidence
- Understanding infant development
- Strengthening attachment with their baby
- Implementing family routines
- Creating linkages to their local community
- Strengthening family relationships
- Recognising their baby's cues and needs
- Advocacy and referrals to other services

Referral Criteria

Referrals can be taken for the Community Bubs from the last trimester of pregnancy, up until the baby is 6 months of age, for families residing in the Bayside Peninsula area.

Community Bubs is an inclusive program which works with a diverse range of families, taking into consideration collective and individual needs. Community Bubs welcomes referrals for parents and carers of all genders, abilities, religions and cultural backgrounds.
